

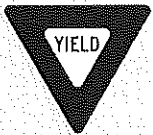
## How to Drive Through a Roundabout

### YIELD

The "Golden Rule" of roundabouts.

Prior to entering and exiting the roundabout, you must yield to pedestrians and bicyclists in the crosswalk.

Remember, you must yield to all circulating traffic as drivers in the circle have the right of way.



Drivers must yield to pedestrians and bicyclists in the crosswalks.



Enter only when there is a safe gap in traffic.

Yield to all traffic coming from the left.

Circulating traffic has the right of way. Continue to your exit and do not stop within the roundabout.

The driver in the roundabout can either exit or continue circulating. Entering vehicles must yield to all traffic coming from the left.
