The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will hold a public involvement meeting to provide an update on project scope, purpose and need, and gather public input on the proposed improvements for the I-39/90 and [US 12/18](#)(Beltline) interchange near Madison in Dane County.

WisDOT is preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) to document the environmental effects of the Beltline Interchange project. This new approach is intended to reduce impacts and enable significant savings in the estimated cost of the interchange. This will provide an opportunity to improve safety as it affects Interstate travel through the interchange, while utilizing the remaining life of the infrastructure.

Property owners along I-39/90 between Door Creek and [US 12/18](#) are especially encouraged to attend to discuss potential impacts to their property prior to the start of real estate acquisitions scheduled for this summer.

You are encouraged to attend the meeting, provide input and ask questions regarding this project. Maps and exhibits showing the current Range of Alternatives of the project's potential impacts will be on display. WisDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project on an individual basis.
