

Good afternoon,

Next week (April 3-7) is Work Zone Awareness Week in Wisconsin. Work zones can be challenging – often involving lane shifts, narrow or uneven pavements and reduced speeds. Highway workers are vulnerable – often working just feet away from moving traffic – but most work zone deaths and injuries involve motorists traveling through a work zone. Last year, over 2,800 crashes occurred in Wisconsin work zones resulting in 9 deaths and 1,110 injuries.

Weekly Construction Update: April 3-7

All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.

Two lanes remain open to traffic on I-39/90 (in each direction) during daytime hours.

NOTE: Next week Monday through Friday, nightly single lane closures (8 p.m. – 5 a.m.) are planned on I-39/90 northbound and southbound in the following work zones, unless noted otherwise. Minor delays may occur during these lane closures.

County AB bridge replacement over I-39/90, south of Madison

- **Updated:** [View County AB bridge operations.](#)
- **Updated:** Bridge removal anticipated during nighttime hours from April 10-12 – weather dependent and subject to change.
 - Overnight closures of I-39/90 with signed detour routes; more information to be shared next week.
 - Noise is expected with these operations from bridge deck and girder removal.
- County AB over I-39/90 is CLOSED to all traffic until early September 2017.
 - Alternate routes are required. Signed detour route: US 12/18, County N and County MN.

I-39/90 (Dane/Rock County line to E. Church Road) and US 51 interchange, east of Stoughton

 - Be alert for lane shifts, and please stay in your lane!

I-39/90 and WIS 59 interchange and Rock River bridges, near Edgerton and Newville

- I-39/90 northbound traffic shifted onto the new concrete lanes and bridge over the Rock River.
 - Be alert for lane shifts and slow down – reduced speed limit of 60 mph.

 - Navigational buoys to be placed in river under I-39/90. Boaters should slow down (this area is no wake), and be alert for construction crews and work taking place.
- **Updated:** Ellendale Road to be CLOSED under I-39/90 from 6 p.m. Tuesday (April 4) until 6 a.m. Friday morning (April 7). A crane will be placed in the roadway to set girders for the other half of the northbound Interstate bridge. These operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
 - At other times, flagging operations will occur periodically on Ellendale Road as crews unload trucks and reach material stored along the road.

- **Updated:** Richardson Springs Road to be CLOSED under I-39/90 from 8 p.m. Friday (April 7) until 8 a.m. Saturday morning (April 8). A crane will be placed in the roadway to set girders for the other half of the northbound Interstate bridge. These operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
 - Crews will periodically open the roadway for local traffic. Please plan ahead and allow extra time.
