Motion by Supervisor Bolender, second by Supervisor Olson to approve the pre-paid 2021-2022 Energy Purchase Contract with Alcivia for a base price of 1.579 for 3,150 gallons. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Supervisor Olson, second by Sup. Bolender, to invest the CD from One Community Bank to a Money Market Account at Heritage at .30%. Motion carried 4-0.
